

In line with its constitution the European Urban Research Association (EURA) is seeking to elect a new president for the legislative period 2017 - 2021.

Profile

The new president is expected to have a high academic reputation and a good set of network relationships. Strong leadership skills are required. The candidate must demonstrate a firm commitment to the core aims of EURA as established in 1997. These are:

- Encourage international exchange and co-operation in relation to urban research
- Stimulate and encourage interdisciplinary and cross-national urban research
- Contribute to urban policy debate

Candidates for the EURA President role must be a member of EURA – either by virtue of institutional or individual membership.

Responsibilities

Part of the task of the president is to host the EURA Secretariat which is currently based in the Faculty of Spatial Planning within the Technical University of Dortmund. During the transition of the EURA Secretariat and depending on the context of the new Secretariat logistics, the incoming EURA President may have to liaise with the current EURA Secretariat at the Faculty of Spatial Planning within the Technical University of Dortmund until the secretariat is transferred to the new host institution. The Secretariat is responsible for the maintenance of the webpage, the distribution of information in the EURA network (newsletter etc.), preparation of board meetings and membership administration.

The new president will be elected in the General Assembly meeting at the EURA conference 2017 in Warsaw (21-24 June).
