Organisation

The work of the Association is overseen by a Governing Board of 23 people representing 17 countries. The Association also works to link European researchers with their counterparts in the rest of the world, particularly through an affiliate relationship with urbanists in the Urban Affairs Association.

- **Institutional members** receive the Newsletter (pdf-version) and can access special services. Members of their staff are eligible for reduced rates at EURA events.
Fee: 240 euro per year.
- **East European Institutional members** enjoy the same benefits as other Institutional Members but pay a reduced fee.
Fee: 160 euro per year.
- **Individual members** receive the Newsletter (pdf-version) and are eligible for reduced rates at EURA events.
Fee: 60 euro per year.
- **Retired Individual members** receive the Newsletter (pdf-version) and are eligible for reduced rates at EURA events.
Fee: 48 euro per year.
- **Research student members** receive the Newsletter (pdf-version) and are eligible for reduced rates at EURA events.
Fee: 48 euro per year.
- **Colleagues in Eastern Europe** receive the Newsletter (pdf-version) and are eligible for reduced rates at EURA events.
Fee: 48 euro per year.
